On arrival for an appointment, please check-in with the receptionist or the automated check in board.

Home Visits

If someone is too ill to come to the surgery, a home visit can be requested.

Please telephone the surgery before 10.30am giving the patient's name, address, telephone number where they can be contacted and a brief description of their symptoms.

Home visits are reserved for those who are housebound or too ill to go out. The doctor will phone you to discuss your request and the most seriously ill patients will be visited first. Transport difficulties are not an appropriate reason for a home visit.

Repeat Prescriptions

Repeat Prescriptions may be ordered on our website or by calling 028 90 204336. The prescription should be ready for collection in 48 hours from 1.30pm or may be issued by post if a patient provides a stamped addressed envelope.
